On behalf of the Coalition, the Cook County Department of Environmental Control received an award of **\$600,000** in 2014 from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for environmental assessment of brownfields in **Bellwood, Forest Park, Franklin Park, Maywood, Melrose Park, Northlake** and **Schiller Park**. The goal of this project is to remove uncertainty about environmental conditions and return vacant or underdeveloped land to productive use.

This event will celebrate redevelopment already taking place on some of the sites, and showcase other sites that will be available for reuse. And since the project is still in process through September 2017, additional sites may be suggested.
