Overall, the village's tax levy is about 2.8 % but the village itself still remains at zero percent increase. Any property tax increase is due the Bellwood Public Library. It's the 2022 levy collected in 2023. \$16,164,110.00 hasn't changed for twelve years.

All Trustees were in favor to open the floor. Upon a voice vote, the motion carried unanimously. Mayor Harvey declared the floor for public comment open.


