- ***Citizenship:*** Must be a U.S. Citizen
- ***Driver's License:*** Must possess a valid Driver's License at the time of application with the ability to obtain an Illinois Driver's License upon time of hire.
- ***Age Requirement:*** Applicants must have attained their 21<sup>st</sup> birthday by the last date for filing applications (8/26/20). Must be under the age of 35 years on 8/26/2020 and when final eligibility register is posted unless exempt by State Statute 65 IL 5/10 – 2. 1-6 which provides, in part, that the age limitation does not apply to any person previously employed as a certified full-time Police Officer for a municipality in the U.S.
- ***Education:*** Must have proof of High School Diploma, GED Certificate or High School Proficiency Statement.
- ***Residence:*** At this time there is no stated requirements for residency declared by the Village of Bellwood.
