

Crossing Guard (Part-time)

Job Summary:

This is a part-time position that assists children and other pedestrians in crossing at specified streets along school routes.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

Required Education/Experience/Skills	
	Reports students who do not adhere to safe street crossing procedures to appropriate school officials.
	Instructs children in proper procedures for safe street crossing.
	Stops traffic and escorts pedestrians into the street allowing them to cross safely.
	Assembles children and other pedestrians behind curb lines awaiting traffic lulls or signal changes.

A minimum of 18 years of age
High School Diploma or GED
Ability to communicate with children and adults effectively

Physical Requirements and Working Conditions:

Must possess stamina to stand for long periods of time; mobility to escort pedestrians across the street; ability to work outdoors in good and/or inclement weather conditions; good vision for reading printed materials and license plates; and being able to hear and speak well when communicating to others.

Hours & Compensation:

Crossing Guards are on duty between 7:00 am - 8:30 am and again between 2:00 pm and 3:30 pm. The hourly rate for this position is \$13.00.
