



Crossing Guard (Part-time)

Job Summary:

This is a part-time position that provides assistance to children and other pedestrians in crossing at specified streets along school routes; and performs related work as required.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assembles children and other pedestrians behind curb lines awaiting traffic lulls or signal changes.
- Stops traffic and escorts pedestrians into the street allowing them to cross safely.
- Instructs children in proper procedures for safe street crossing.
- Reports students who do not adhere to safe street crossing procedures to appropriate school officials.
- Performs other duties of a similar nature or level.

Required Education/Experience/Skills

- A minimum of 18 years of age
- High School Diploma or GED
- Valid Illinois Driver's License
- Illinois Rules of the Road
- Ability to communicate with children and adults effectively

Physical Requirements and Working Conditions:

Must possess stamina to stand for long periods of time; mobility to escort pedestrians across the street; ability to work outdoors in good and/or inclement weather conditions; good vision for reading printed materials and license plates; and being able to hear and speak well when communicating to others.

Hours & Compensation:

Crossing Guards are on duty between 7:00 am - 8:30 am and again between 2:00 pm and 3:30 pm. The hourly rate for this position is \$11.22.
