
Recommendation: Village Staff recommends the approval of the attached ordinance

ORDINANCE NO. 18-12

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING
PREVAILING WAGE RATES TO BE PAID TO
LABORERS, MECHANICS AND OTHER WORKERS
PERFORMING CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC WORKS IN
THE VILLAGE OF BELLWOOD**

WHEREAS, the Village of Bellwood is a home rule unit of local government with authority granted pursuant to the Illinois Constitution of 1970, to exercise certain powers and perform certain functions pertaining to its local government and affairs;

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted the Prevailing Wage Act, approved June 26, 1941, as amended, being 820 ILCS 130/0.01 through 130/12 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act");

WHEREAS, the Act requires that during the month of June of each calendar year the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellwood (hereinafter referred to as "Village") investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages, as defined in said Act, in the "locality" of the Village for laborers, mechanics and other workers performing construction of public works for the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, in open meeting assembled, by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellwood, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section One - Recitals

The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preamble to the Ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance as legislative findings.

Section Two – Adoption of Determination:

- a) To the extent and as required by the Act, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in the construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the Village is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing wages for construction work in Cook County as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois (hereinafter referred to as the "Department") which are in

effect on June 1, 2018. If the Department adopts different rates after June 1, 2018 during the month of June, 2018, a copy of that determination will be appended hereto and incorporated herein by reference when it is available from the Department. As required by said Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages by the Department shall supersede the Department's June determination and apply to any and all public works construction undertaken by the Village. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used the Act shall be the same as the Act.

- b) Nothing herein contained is intended to apply nor shall be construed to apply said prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment performed on behalf of this Village except public works construction to the extent required by the Act.
- c) The Village Clerk shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of this Village this determination of prevailing rate of wages. A copy of this determination or of the current revised determination of prevailing rate of wages then in effect shall be attached to all contract specifications.
- d) By July 15, the Village Clerk shall file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Illinois Department of Labor.
- e) Within thirty (30) days after filing a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Secretary of State, the Village Clerk shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area a notice that this determination is effective and constitutes the determination of the public body or the Village may, pursuant to 820 ILCS 130/9, satisfy the Prevailing Wage Act's notice of publishing by posting same on the website maintained by the public body in lieu of a newspaper of general circulation.
- f) The Village Clerk shall mail a copy of this Ordinance to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

Section Six – Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Section Seven - Conflict Clause

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the terms of this Ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of said conflict.

Section Eight – Saving Clause

If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of law to be invalid or unconstitutional, the invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of the Bellwood Park Municipal Code, which are hereby declared to be separable.

Section Nine - Publication

This Ordinance shall be published in book or pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code.

Section Ten - Recording

This Ordinance shall be entered into the minutes and upon the journals of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellwood.




